Boulder County CareConnect provides volunteer-powered safety net services that help local **seniors** and **adults with disabilities** stay **safe** and **live more independently**. In addition to our **five safety net programs**, we've also been the **local hub** for the national **RSVP 55+** volunteer program since 1972.

2015 HIGHLIGHTS

- **Leadership.** BCCC's board of directors hired Jim Rianoshek as executive director. Jim recruited key staff members with the goal of evolving and growing programs to meet the increasing demand for services.
- **Efficiency.** Management completed a comprehensive internal audit and restructuring, resulting in streamlined program delivery and reporting.
- **Community.** The "360 Assessment Survey" invited community members to help determine BCCC's future direction and priorities.
- **Collective Impact.** Staff renewed emphasis on aligning and working with local businesses and nonprofits to maximize impact.

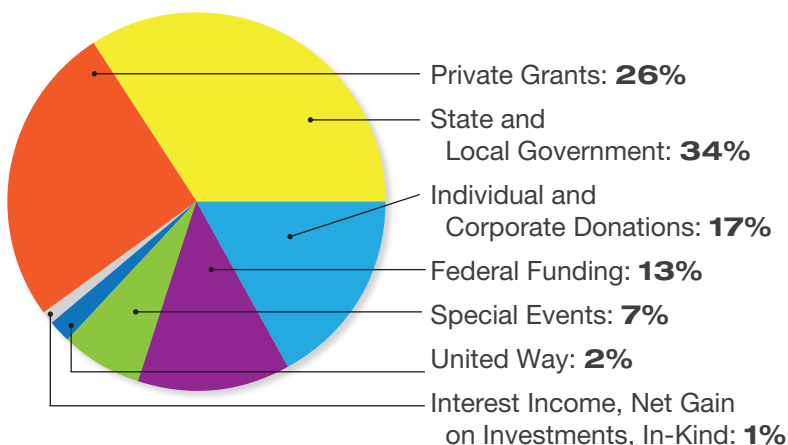

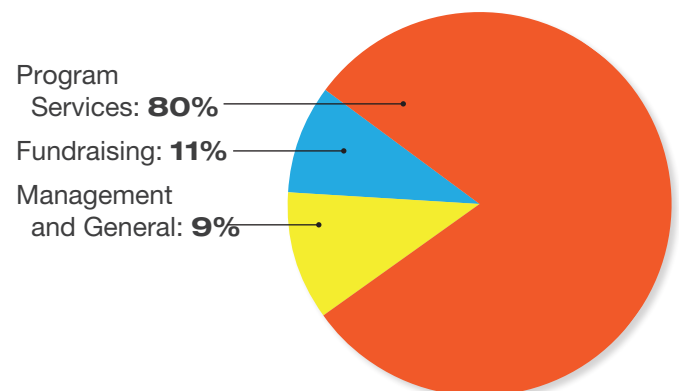
