Volunteer Job Description

Commitment: Our ideal volunteer maintains some flexibility in service and is able to commit to volunteering during the winter/snow months. Volunteers will shovel walkways and sidewalks within 24 hours after a snowfall.

Program Description and Goals:

Our volunteers will be on the spot within 24 hours of a snowfall to help seniors have snow-free sidewalks and walkways. This can be a solo volunteer position or with partners or can be a shared role within a family or pair. Volunteers are assigned one or more clients. The program provides services in Boulder County.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Shovel snow from sidewalks, walkways and some driveways.
- Due to COVID, all volunteers must wear masks while on the client's property. If you become ill or come into contact with someone who is ill, please let us know and **DO NOT** come to volunteer.
- If the sidewalk is shoveled before you get there **2 or more times**, please notify the office and we will work to find you a new client who can use the service.
- Provide Feedback and ask Questions!- Cultivate staff are there to help and support you
- May need to lay down salt or snow melt for some clients.
- Maintain clear communication with clients and supervisor. Please note that we cannot provide a substitute when a volunteer is out of town or otherwise unable to shovel.
- Be familiar with Cultivate rules. If you don't know, please ask.
- Be sure to say "Hi" to your client if you see them!
- Time per home should be less than one hour.
