VetsGo Drivers escort veterans and their family members to and from their medical appointments while providing companionship along the way.

Time Commitment

Our ideal volunteers are able to commit to a minimum of 2-3 rides each month. Most escorted rides require waiting for return trip, which may include a stop at the pharmacy.

Volunteer Job Description

- Provide timely and reliable transportation to the medical appointment
- Provide door to door service including accompaniment to office if necessary
- Drive to Pharmacy if needed after appointment

Duties and Responsibilities

- Attend a volunteer orientation and complete volunteer paperwork prior to first ride
- Provide Feedback and ask Questions!- Cultivate staff are there to help and support you
- Be familiar with and follow all procedures and rules as described in the volunteer handbook and at orientation
- All drivers must have a valid driver's license and a clean driving record
- Drivers must have vehicle liability insurance policy on file
- Get to know your clients! Provide a willing ear, a friendly conversation
