Volunteer Job Description

YardBusters volunteers work outside in the yards of our clients to keep their walkways cleared and safe, and to maintain their yards and walks in such a fashion as to avoid code violations in Boulder County. Being a YardBuster doesn't require a green thumb but a familiarity with lawn care, pruning, weeding and planting is preferred.

Time Commitment

Our ideal volunteer is able to help out at more than once. Volunteers can sign up for anything from 2 to 5 or more hours in a day.

Volunteer Job Description

- Perform approved yardwork (See Do's and Don'ts list for details)
- Clean up and gather tools to be picked up by Cultivate staff

Duties and Responsibilities

- Complete volunteer paperwork prior to volunteering
- Be familiar with and follow all procedures and rules as described in the volunteer handbook and communicated to you on the day of your volunteer service
- Raking, weeding, mowing and bagging trim in the yards of clients
- Introduce yourself to your client while maintaining social distancing
- Wear personal protective equipment

- Enjoy working in the yard and getting your hands in soil
